HOW IT WORKS

Membership, Not Booking

NAORA operates on a membership model. Instead of booking a trip, you join a community that has ongoing access to the journey. You choose when to board, how long to stay, and when to return.

Join

Become a member and gain access to the journey at any point along the route.

Board

Choose a boarding location that works for your schedule and travel plans.

Leave & Return

Step off when you need to. Come back when you're ready. The journey continues.

A Continuous Loop Around the World

The yacht follows the seasons and the tradewinds — moving through the world's most beautiful sailing regions in a natural, unhurried rhythm. There is no fixed start or end. The journey is ongoing.

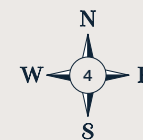

BOARDING

Joining the Yacht Is Simple

There's no fixed starting point. You board wherever the yacht is when your membership period begins. NAORA provides clear guidance on the nearest airports, local transfers, and timing — so your arrival is smooth from the moment you land.



→ **You receive your boarding location**
Confirmed 3–4 weeks before your arrival date.

→ **We guide you on logistics**
Nearest airport, transfer options, and what to bring.

→ **You arrive, we take care of the rest**
The crew meets you and helps you settle in immediately.



PACKING

What to Bring and What to Leave Behind

Storage space on board is generous, but we'd rather fill it with good company than hard-shell suitcases. One soft bag per person keeps things easy for everyone.

**One Soft Bag**

A duffel or soft-shell bag only. No hard-shell suitcases or wheeled luggage they're difficult to store on board.

**Warm Weather Clothing**

Light clothes, swimwear, shorts, and sandals. You'll live in them.

**A Layer or Two**

A sweater, light jacket, and something for occasional rain depending on the region.

**Deck Shoes or Bare Feet**

Non-marking soles only on deck. Flip-flops for shore.

**Sun Protection**

Sunglasses, a hat, and UV-protective clothing for long days on the water.

**Something to Read**

Books, a journal, or whatever helps you slow down.

 Sunscreen, soap, shampoo, and basic toiletries are provided on board. No need to pack them.



ONBOARD LIFE

Life at Sea, Day by Day

Life on NAORA is calm and unstructured by design. There's a professional crew — captain, chef, and stewardess — so nothing falls on you. Your only job is to be present.

01.

Morning

Fresh coffee at sunrise. Swim off the deck. A light breakfast prepared by the chef.

02.

Day

Sail to a new anchorage. Snorkel, paddleboard, read, or simply sit. No agenda.

03.

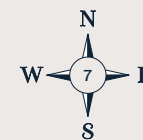
Evening

01. Founders & Investors

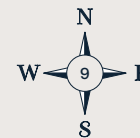
People who have built things and are ready to step away from the noise for a while.

A few weeks to reset, experience a specific region, and reconnect with yourself.

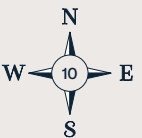
Extended Stay

Everything You Need, Nothing Extra

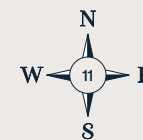
Included

- Onboarding guidance and logistics support

- Flights and travel to boarding location
- Premium wines and spirits
- Personal expenses ashore
- Scuba diving onshore (available locally)
- Travel insurance (required)

THE VESSEL

A Floating Villa, Not a Boat

NAORA sails on a Lagoon Eighty 2 — one of the most advanced luxury catamarans in the world. At 80 feet, it offers space, stability, and privacy that feel nothing like a typical sailing experience.

Multiple private cabins, a large saloon, open deck areas, and shaded lounges.

Stable

The wide catamaran hull minimizes rolling — comfortable even in open seas.

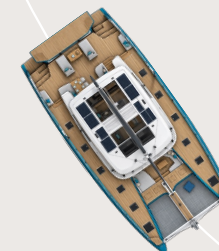

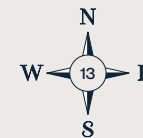

① The Eighty 2 is equipped with diesel engines. We are fully aware of our ecological footprint and do everything we can to minimize it sailing under wind power whenever possible. But when the engine is needed, we need to be able to rely on it completely. For a journey to the edges of the world, electric motors are not yet stable or reliable enough. We choose diesel not out of indifference, but out of responsibility to our crew and members.



WHY A CATAMARAN

Why a Catamaran and Not a Monohull

The catamaran isn't just a preference it's a deliberate choice for comfort, safety, and access, making it the ideal vessel for a continuous global journey.

01. Stability

Minimized rolling motions provide a smoother, more comfortable experience even in open seas.

02. Space

Expansive decks, a generous saloon, and multiple private areas offer unparalleled living space.

03. Safety

Dual hulls offer inherent redundancy & increased buoyancy, contributing to greater peace of mind.

04. Shallow Draft

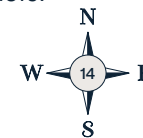
Access to secluded bays & anchorages that traditional monohulls cannot reach, enhancing exploration.

05. Speed

Efficient hull design allows for faster passage-making under sail, covering more ground with less effort.

06. Comfort

Less heeling & a stable platform mean a more pleasant journey for everyone, especially non-sailors.

Safety is never an afterthought on NAORA. Every element of the journey from route planning to daily operations is managed by a certified, experienced crew.

Certified Captain & Crew

Fully licensed professionals with deep-water passage experience across multiple ocean crossings.

Safety Briefings

Every member receives a calm, thorough orientation on arrival no experience needed to feel confident.

English is the Language on Board

The primary language spoken by the crew and used for all safety briefings and daily communication is English. A basic level of English is recommended for all members.

Careful Route Planning

Routes follow seasonal weather windows and established tradewind passages minimizing discomfort.

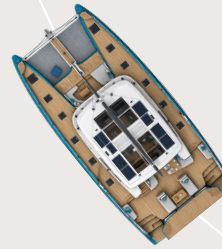

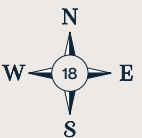
SOCIAL LIFE

Who NAORA Is For — and Who It Isn't

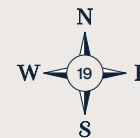
NAORA is for you if...
